Ultra Compact Nozzles wins Scottish Tender

Delta Fire is delighted to announce its success in being awarded the contract for the supply of select flow mainline fire-fighting nozzles for the Scottish F.R.S. Grampian F.R.S conducted a robust evaluation process on behalf of the whole Scottish Fire & Rescue Service and chose the Delta nozzles as being the most suitable to meet their arduous requirements. Grampian have initially purchased 140 nozzles with Highlands & Islands following with an order for 132.

Delta Fire has designed and produced Attack and Defence nozzles which are uniquely colour coded for Attack and Defence operations as per the requirements of Grampian F.R.S.

The two computer designed nozzles have been engineered in an ultra compact design which maximises performance to the size and weight of the nozzle. The powerful stainless steel spinning turbine teeth produce exceptionally good spray fog patterns even at low pressures, making them ideal for dealing with compartment fires in high rise buildings a requirement recently highlighted in a paper from the OPDM.

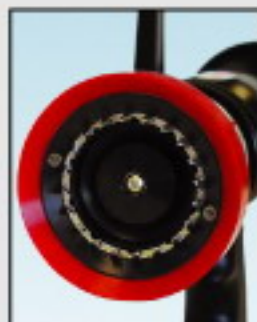
Grampian Fire and Rescue Service is delighted to announce that Delta Fire was successful in being awarded the contract for the supply of mainline fire-fighting nozzles for the service.

Grampian Fire and Rescue Service for and on behalf of all Scottish F.R.S. conducted a robust evaluation process for the provision of mainline fire fighting nozzles. Delta Fire was successful in being awarded the contract for the supply of approximately 140 "attack" and "defence" type nozzles. These nozzles will replace the existing ageing nozzles and are unique in that they provide a colour coding system to the user. The nozzle bumper, pistol grip and handle are coloured red and green respectively; red being "defence" type and green being "attack" type. From a risk management and innovative process this is a significant step forward for all Scottish F.R.S.

Comments from Chief Fire Officer:

Chief Fire Officer David Dalziel of Grampian Fire and Rescue Service welcomed the introduction of this modern and highly effective operational equipment on frontline use. 'Crew safety and the innovative use of technology to enhance fire fighting whilst reducing potential unnecessary water damage, are areas we sought from the outset and the award of this contract demonstrates the benefits of a robust evaluation processes.
